- c. Industry-related experience.
- d. Proficiency in MS Office and other TUT-related software/computer programs.
- e. Full proficiency in English is a prerequisite.
- f. Completion of a TUT License to Teach programme will be compulsory.
- g. Attend an orientation program at TUT.
